KPrep-12th Grade Girls

DAILY UNIFORM



Khaki or navy skirt that **falls to the top of the knee**, skort, jumper (KP-4th), or pants (no cargo pants)

- Pants must be “khaki” material; no khaki colored jeans
- Only KPrep-K girls may wear elastic-waist pants
- Modest shorts (minimum length mid-thigh) must be worn under skirts and jumpers (i.e., sliders, modesty shorts, biker shorts)

A brown or black belt must be worn with pants; pants must have belt loops

- No belt is needed for KPrep-K girls who wear elastic-waist pants

Navy, white, or maroon short or long-sleeve polo (no logos, other than the Regents Academy logo)

- Polo options above should be worn under jumpers

Maroon or navy polo dress (KP-4th)

Simple, conservative tennis shoes, close-toed and close-heeled flats, or ankle-length boots

- No distracting designs, lights, or characters

Students should wear socks that support the professional and uniform appearance of the school dress code. Designs that draw attention to the wearer are not permitted.

Blue Jeans (no rips or holes) & a black or brown belt

KPrep-12th Grade Boys



Khaki or navy pants or uniform shorts (shorts only KP-6th)

- Pants must be “khaki” material; no khaki colored jeans
- Only KPrep-K boys may wear elastic-waist pants or uniform shorts
- No cargo pants or cargo shorts

A brown or black belt must be worn with pants; pants must have belt loops

- No belt is needed for KPrep-K boys who wear elastic-waist pants

White, short or long-sleeve blouse with Peter Pan collar (woven, not knit).

Navy, knee-high socks or navy tights

Brown, black, or navy flat dress shoes

5-6th Grade Girls



Custom Plaid Box Pleat Skirt* (must be purchased through our [Lands' End online store](#))

- **Skirts must fall to the top of the knee**, and modest shorts (minimum length mid-thigh) must be worn under skirts (i.e., sliders, modesty shorts, biker shorts)

White, short or long-sleeve blouse (no cap sleeve or 3/4 sleeve). Wear a white camisole or tank top under, if needed.

Gray Pleat Skirt (Below the Knee from our [Lands' End online store](#))

- **Skirts must fall to the top of the knee**, and modest shorts (minimum length mid-thigh) must be worn under skirts (i.e., sliders, modesty shorts, biker shorts)

White, short or long-sleeve blouse (no cap sleeve or 3/4 sleeve). Wear a white camisole or tank top under, if needed.

KPrep-6th Grade Boys



Gray dress pants/slacks

- KPrep-K boys may wear elastic-waist dress pants/slacks

White, short or long-sleeve dress shirt

Rose plaid or solid maroon tie (must be purchased through the front office)

A brown or black belt

- No belt is needed for KPrep-K boys who wear elastic-waist slacks

Brown or black dress shoes or boots

- No casual tennis shoes or sneakers (e.g., Hey Dudes, Vans)

Students should wear socks that support the professional and uniform appearance of the school dress code. Designs that draw attention to the wearer are not permitted.

7-12th Grade Boys



Gray dress pants/slacks

White, short or long-sleeve dress shirt

Navy blazer

- With school patch on the left side (for sale in the front office)

Solid maroon tie (must be purchased through our [Lands' End online store](#) or the front office)

A brown or black belt

Brown or black dress shoes or boots

- No casual tennis shoes or sneakers (e.g., Hey Dudes, Vans)

OUTERWEAR

KP-12th Grade Girls & Boys

Navy cardigan, fleece, or jacket

- **No hoodies**, no logo other than the Regents logo

Letter Jacket (grades 10-12)

Maroon, gray, or navy Regents sweatshirt (for sale in the front office)

P.E.

6-10th Grade Girls & Boys

Gray Regents T-shirt

- Must be purchased from the front office

Black shorts

- Must be purchased from the front office
- Shorts must fall below fingertips

5th graders are encouraged to wear a Regents PE Uniform, but not required.



ADDITIONAL APPEARANCE STANDARDS

KP-12th Grade Girls

- Hairstyles must be natural, practical, and moderate, and hair must be kept a natural color.
- Makeup is reserved for upper school girls. It may be worn neatly and must be appropriately inconspicuous.
- Jewelry and accessories, if worn, must be simple, conservative, and appropriate to the student's overall appearance. They should not be distracting to the student or others.
- No accessories or paraphernalia associated with a culture or movement in conflict with Regents Academy standards.
- Dress and grooming should be clean, neat, and conducive to order and learning.

KP-12th Grade Boys

- Hair should be no longer than mid-ear, not extend beyond the top of the collar and kept a natural color. No partial or complete shaving of the head or severe step cuts or unusually asymmetrical styling of the hair (e.g., mohawks, mullets).
- Beards and mustaches are not to be worn by students. Young men should be clean-shaven.
- Jewelry and accessories, if worn, must be simple, conservative, and appropriate to the student's overall appearance. They should not be distracting to the student or others.
- No accessories or paraphernalia associated with a culture or movement in conflict with Regents Academy standards.
- Dress and grooming should be clean, neat, and conducive to order and learning.
